

Parking Rules

Here is a summary of the applicable rules:

- 1. <u>Basic Rule</u>. The basic rule for your personal vehicles, as well as your visitors' and guests' vehicles, is that on-street parking is permitted during the day, but not overnight. "Overnight" means the time period beginning at midnight and ending at 6:00 AM. The basic rule for vendors, construction, service, and delivery vehicles is that they may be parked on the street during the day, but only for so long as reasonably necessary to provide service or make delivery. No overnight parking of any personal or commercial vehicle is permitted on any street at any time.
- 2. Exception. There is a short-term exception to the overnight parking prohibition that applies to travel trailers and recreational vehicles. This exception was designed to accommodate occasional out-of-town visitors to your homes as well as your own travel preparations. It reads as follows: No travel trailers or recreational vehicles shall be parked in any street, or on or near any Lot, for more than 48 hours, or for more than 72 hours in any 30-day period.
- 3. Other Vehicles. Except as permitted in rules 1 and 2, above, no commercial vehicles or equipment, mobile homes, recreational vehicles, boats and other watercraft, trailers, stored vehicles, or inoperable vehicles may be parked in any street, or on or near any Lot, at any time. They must be parked in enclosed garages.
